## Children's Medical Services (CMS) Overview

- Serves children from birth to age 21 with special health care needs and their families who are below 236% FPL
- CMS enrolled foster care, adoption assistance and DJJ clients have the option to opt out of Georgia Families 360° Amerigroup enrollment.

#### **CMS Provided Services**

- Care Coordination
  - Provided by a Public Health nurse
  - Family focused decision making
  - Development of Comprehensive Plan of Care
  - Transition plan for 16-21 year olds
  - Linkage to a medical home
  - Referral to community based services
- Clinical Services
  - Provided in 10 Public Health Districts, including 2 telemedicine clinics
  - Support coordinated management of chronic health conditions
  - Include asthma, diabetes, cardiac, genetic, developmental, orthopedic, and neurology/seizure

## **CMS Financed Services**


CMS may assist in paying for medical services that include:

- Care Coordination Services
- Comprehensive Physical Assessment
- Dental Care (if related to CMS eligible condition)
- Diagnostic Testing
- Durable Medical Equipment
- Genetic Consultations
- Health Education
- Hearing Aids
- Inpatient/Outpatient Hospital Services
- Medications and Medical Treatments
