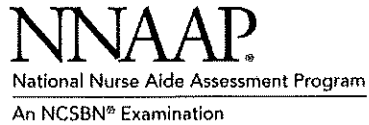

2018 NNAAP® Equipment List for Skills Evaluation

Greetings:

Pearson VUE has revised the Equipment List for the NNAAP Skills Evaluation scheduled for administration beginning in July 2018.

The changes include the addition of XXL clothing tops for "Dresses Client with Affected (Weak) Right Arm," requirement that the PPE isolation gown secure in the back or the side (cannot secure in the front), and a small increase in the number of washcloths and towels required per candidate testing. Although the equipment list changes are not required until the administration of the revised Skills Evaluation scheduled for July, Pearson VUE is providing this preview to help with your planning.
